**Results of the "email vote" on the final budget for 2015-16 academic year**

Final Budget was approved. Additionally, there was an e-mail vote in June to move \$8,000 from general account to the playground account and this was approved.

**Treasurer's Report, Kelly Braswell**

Kelly reported savings account balance of \$2,728.24, Playground account balance of \$1,344.62 with items pending, and checking account balance of \$8,942.38 with transactions pending.

**Principal's Report, Deb Dabbert**

Enrollment has been fluctuating as families move in and out of the school over the summer. Current enrollment is 312 students. There will be 3 sections of grades K - 2 for the coming school year. Administration has been busy with many staff changes. These will be announced in the principal's newsletter when all is finalized. Class lists will be posted at the Open House. These have included technology workshops, Anita Archer conducted workshops on explicit instruction, and workshops on BIST, which is one of the classroom management plans implemented at Eastridge.
