Principal's Report, Deb Dabbert: Mrs. Dabbert reported on the Park and Rec Department planning meeting regarding proposed changes to the Taylor Park Playground. The reasons for the changes are some equiptment is not up to current code such as the castle slide and the nearby creek embankment needs improvement. The proposed new site is near Eastridge Pool. It would be geared towards children ages 3-7 and incorporate a picnic shelter. Most of the neighborhood residents who spoke at the meeting were in favor of keeping the playground at its current site.
